To apply for a grant, please provide us with the following information:

PROJECT DETAILS

Project Title *

Logline: (50 words or less) * Provide a brief, catchy summary of your project.

Story Summary / Synopsis (500 words or less) *

Give an overview of your story, introduce your main character(s) and describe your narrative trajectory.

Biography (250 words max) *

Include key your role(s) (you must be the writer, director, and/or producer to apply for this grant). Provide brief bios for the key creative member(s). For each member, include information about relevant experience and expertise, notable credits or major recognition or award information.

*Note: Principal photography must be finished and you must be in the post-production phase or beyond to qualify.

Resume (PDF only) *

When submitting your Grant Application, attach your resume as a PDF file.

Project Status: At what stage of production are you in? (500 words or less) *

Give an overview of your story, introduce your main character(s) and describe your narrative trajectory.

Distribution and Marketing Strategy (500 words max) *

Describe the intended distribution for your film. Specify plans for festival, theatrical or community screenings as well as your plans for further securing broadcast and/ or distribution.

Describe the audience you anticipate for your project, including any underserved audiences.

- How have you addressed the needs and interests of this audience in your project?
- What is your relationship with and access to this community?
- If applicable, what actions do you hope for viewers to take after seeing your film?
- Do you have partnerships in place?
